Qualified members of the military, foreign service and intelligence communities who served on official extended duty outside of the U.S. for 90 days or more between Jan. 1, 2009, and April 30, 2010, have another year—until April 30, 2011—to buy a home and claim the \$8,000 first-time or \$6,500 repeat home buyer tax credit.
